



My Biography: Lenka Frnčová, Czech Republic (WEINLINIE)

I have been breeding and training hunting dogs since I was 21 years old. My first breed was a Slovak kopov and soon after a beagle, which accompanies me to this day. For many years my companions were also German toy spitz. My kennel is called "WEINLINIE" (formerly Blýskavica according to the gamekeeper's house in the Javorie mountains in Slovakia, where I lived for 11 years). My breeding is focused on quality exterior and I prefer only healthy dogs in my breeding program. Now I work more as an exterior judging judge and have judged in 24 countries around the world. Currently, I work mainly as an international FCI judge for judging the exterior of dogs. My training began in 1998, in 2000 I started judging the Beagle breed and in 2025 I was appointed all-breed international judge under the FCI.

I am have also an international judge for hunting trials for hounds not only in the Czech Republic but also abroad. I have also been actively accompanying dogs at hunting trials all the time. Almost every day while working in the forest, my husband Ladislav and I move among various hunting dogs, which we enjoy very much. Currently, my husband and I only have a small pack of Beagles, Jack Russell Terriers and Kleiner Münsterländer and we devote all our free time to them.
